Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to you to inform you of progress on the new leisure centre.

As you may have seen over the past month the demolition of the old Tides Leisure centre has gone extremely well and we are now sorting the materials for recycling. We will be looking to surpass industry standards and have set a 90% recycling target with little or no material going to landfill.

You may have also noticed some increased activity within the old nursery area, as we now have some more permanent welfare which we will compliment with the full welfare set up which should be on site early in the new year.

This new set up will allow for safe and effective management of the main project and consist of 'EcoSaver' welfare offices, including drying rooms, canteens, meeting rooms and kitchens.

We have already applied for the temporary services connections necessary to run these units, but we may have to start on generator supplied power. Any generator used for this short term will be silenced, fuel efficient and be subject to agreed working hours of 7.30am to 6pm weekdays, 8am till 1pm Saturdays.

These welfare offices will be double stacked, and the top floor units will have secured window shutters throughout the duration of the project, so everyone's privacy is respected.
